PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Congratulations to all students who competed in the **Cronulla Zone Cross Country Carnival** last Monday and especially to Caragh who placed 4th in the 11 year girls, Sienna who placed 3rd in the 12/13 year girls and Cooper who placed 3rd in the 8/9 boys races. A huge thank you to Miss Horton and Miss Humphreys for supervising students on the day and to Penny Borrill for setting up the Gymea North Marquee. Your help is very much appreciated.

As you are aware, last Tuesday was the first day of **NAPLAN**, which our school is doing online. Unfortunately some minor connectivity issues were experienced during the Year 5 Writing test. However, these issues did not impact Gymea North students. Further NAPLAN testing has gone smoothly with students in Year 3 working well with their online assessments. Year 5 students will complete their Reading test today and will attempt Language Conventions on Tuesday and Maths on Wednesday.

Reminder: Our Open Morning for parents of 2020 Kindergarten students is on Wednesday 29 May in the Hall from 9:30-11:30 am and all are welcome to attend. The visit will include an information session, a tour of our school and a morning tea.

The next **P&C Meeting** will be held tomorrow evening, Tuesday 21 May from 7:00 pm in the staffroom. All are most welcome, so please come along and share your thoughts and ideas and find out what's going on at Gymea North.

Child Protection lessons will be taught in classes this term as part of the Health, Physical Education and Personal Development curriculum. The aim of the program is to empower children by giving them appropriate strategies to use in dealing with situations that are uncomfortable for them and for students to develop protective and assertive skills. Each lesson has a particular focus, including power in relationships, protective strategies and recognising abuse. During one particular lesson, body parts are labelled using the correct terms, with the main idea being that some parts of our bodies are private. Teachers, as always, take care during these lessons to ensure that the class setting is one in which children feel safe, secure and able to discuss their thoughts and feelings. If you require further information or have questions regarding the Child Protection Program you can speak to your child's class teacher or to me.

National Simultaneous Story Time will take place this week on Wednesday at 11:00 am. This is an annual event where students across the country take part in the reading of the same book. This year's text, Alpacas with Maracas, is by Matt Cosgrove and tells of two friends, Macca and Al who have an opportunity to enter a talent contest which they just can't resist.


